School Field Trips

Tuesdays through Thursdays, May 7 through June 13, from 10am to 2pm.

Fridays, May 17 and June 7, 10am to 2pm

**No school field trips on Tuesday, May 28.*

Please arrive at the park between 9:45am-10am, when possible.

An itinerary is created for your students based on the time you will be at the park, anytime between 10am-2pm.

What's included in a School Field Trip:

All trips include a live musical performance of the **T-Rex Feeding Frenzy**, which teaches students what dinosaurs eat through the scientific method; an educational game or activity and a Scavenger Hunt which takes your class on a self-guided tour of the park to see over 30 life size dinosaurs, including the Raptor Maze. If you plan on having lunch at the park, we will schedule a thirty-minute lunch time for your class. With time permitting, there will be time set aside for the dig site and/or another game/activity.

Pricing:

- \$15 per student/teacher/adult/chaperone, plus tax*.
Groups consist of a minimum of 20 tickets. One free chaperone ticket for every 20 student tickets purchased.
**Must submit proof of tax-exempt status 5 days after a reservation is made to avoid sales tax.*
***One complimentary ticket for a school nurse is provided when notified in advance. Without advance notification we cannot guarantee availability.*

Chaperones

- Groups receive one free chaperone for every 20 student tickets purchased.
- Additional chaperones who arrive with the group will be charged the group rate upon entry and must join and remain with the group at all times.
- Additional Parent/Teacher/Chaperone/Adult tickets are NOT available for purchase at the park on the day of a field trip. There are only limited tickets sold for each school day field trip so all tickets must be included in the original reservation to make sure all of your guests receive a ticket.
- For the safety of the children, chaperones who do not arrive with the group, who are not included in the group numbers and who are not on a list provided by the teacher will not be permitted to enter the park.

Payment

A 50% non-refundable deposit or Purchase Order is due two weeks after a reservation is made. Final payment



is due two weeks prior to your trip. Deposits not received by the due date may result in canceled reservations. Payments are not accepted at the park. *Purchase Order due dates may be extended with prior authorization; without prior authorization reservations may be canceled for non-payment.

Unused Tickets

Children/Adults that are absent the day of the trip receive a ticket to return to the park on a future date during the current season. There are no refunds or credits for unused tickets.

Concessions and Lunch Time

Dino-Bites, our concession stand is not open for school field trips. If you are bringing lunch to the park, please have them in large boxes/crates/coolers labeled with your school's and teachers name and grade. An FSD Team member will take your lunches to The Canteen, our picnic area located in the middle of the park. Your lunches will be brought to you during your lunchtime, which is scheduled by the park. Food delivery is not permitted. We have large water coolers for the students to fill up their own water bottles; plastic cups are also available. If a child forgets to bring lunch, please notify an FSD Team Member.

Parking

Parking is free for guests and buses.
